Tuition Full-Year

- \$1,230 Big Band
- \$830 -Small Ensembles

All options require:

- \$100 deposit for small ensembles (to be applied to the registrant's tuition upon placement) and \$200 deposit for Big Band.
- \$30 Registration Fee (to be applied towards tuition fee)

*Nonrefundable and nontransferable deposit and Registration Fee. The deposit will confirm students' participation and will be confirmed once audition materials are submitted on October 25th.
